Das nachstehende Verzeichnis enthält die sämtlichen alten geographischen Namen, unter Beifügung der Qualität und, wo es erforderlich schien, der nichtclassischen und heutigen Namen und mit Angabe der betreffenden Kartenummer und der durch Buchstaben am Kartenrande bezeichneten Felder des Gradnetzes, worin sie auf der Karte zu finden sind. Die Verweisung beschränkt sich für Namen, welche sich auf mehreren Karten wiederholen, auf diejenige Karte, welche bei größerem Maßstabe die meisten Details enthält, indem dadurch die Auffindung auf den anderen Karten von selbst gegeben ist. Die im engsten Sinne topographischen Details, welche den Inhalt der auf Taf. IX enthaltenen Stadtpläne von Rom bilden, sind wegen ihrer Verschiedenartigkeit von dem geographischen Inhalte der übrigen Karten in einem besonderen, am Schlusse beigefügten Index zu dieser Tafel zusammengestellt worden.

An dieser Stelle ist nur über diejenigen sachlichen Anordnungen, welche sich nicht von selbst verstehen, Rechenschaft zu geben.

Die in der griechischen und römischen Litteratur vorkommenden Namen sind in gewöhnlicher Schrift gesetzt, die aus anderen als griechischen und römischen alten Quellen aufgenommenen Namen (sanskritische, baktrische, altpersische, armenische, assyrische, syrische, hebräisch-phönikische, aegyptische, etruskische) sind durch **Lapidarschrift** unterschieden.

Die abgekürzten Bezeichnungen der topographischen Qualität sind die allgemein verständlichen und in lateinischer Sprache gegeben aus Rücksicht auf die lateinische Abfassung der Nomenclatur der Karten und auf das nichtdeutsche Publicum. Unbezeichnet gelassen sind in der Regel bewohnte Ortschaften, ausser wo wegen der Gleichnamigkeit mit Inseln, Bergen, Flüssen die ausdrückliche Bezeichnung als Ortschaft nötig schien, oder wo die historische Zugehörigkeit zu einer von der landschaftlichen Bezeichnung verschiedenen Nation bemerklich zu machen war (z. B. op. gr. = oppidum graecum). Geographische Synonyma sind entweder in Parenthese beigesezt oder durch s. (sive) verbunden; v. bedeutet nicht vel, sondern stets vide in Verweisungen auf andere Artikel.

In den zur Bezeichnung der Lage hinzugefügten Abkürzungen der Landesnamen ist den Gesamtnamen größerer Gebiete, wie Ariana, Graecia, Italia, Gallia u. a. der Name

der speciellen Landschaft (in Parenthese) beigefügt; dagegen bedeuten zwei oder drei ohne Parenthese nebeneinander stehende Landesnamen Zugehörigkeit der betreffenden Örtlichkeit zu beiden, resp. mehreren, was sich bei Gebirgen und größeren Flüssen von selbst erklärt, bei Ortschaften durch schwankende Angaben der antiken Autoritäten, sowie durch historische Veränderungen der Grenzen bedingt wird. So bezeichnet z. B. **Gall. Germ.** einen Ort als auf der unentschiedenen Grenze beider großen Länder gelegen oder zu verschiedenen Zeiten dem einen oder dem anderen derselben angehörig, dagegen **Gall. (Germ.)** in demjenigen Teile der großen römischen Provinz Gallia gelegen, der seit Augustus den Spezialnamen Germania (cisrhenana) führte. Unmittelbar hinter dem Hauptnamen bezeichnet i. diesen als einer Insel angehörig, i. in Parenthese (insulae, Gen.) die Lage des betreffenden Ortes auf der Insel, deren Name folgt.

Alle auf die heutigen (oder überhaupt nachclassischen) Zustände bezüglichen Angaben sind in *Cursivschrift* gesetzt; von topographischen Bezeichnungen ist darin nur für jetzt nicht mehr bewohnte, in Ruinen liegende Ortschaften die Abkürzung *rud.* (rudera) gebraucht worden, und da solche Ruinen häufig nur mittelbar durch benachbarte Orte namentlich zu bezeichnen sind, findet sich öfters dabei die Abkürzung *j.* (juxta) oder *pr.* (prope). Die häufig vorkommenden rein appellativen Benennungen solcher Reste der alten Orte in den heutigen Landessprachen ohne unterscheidenden Beinamen (z. B. ital. *Civita*, *Castelvecchio*, neugriech. *Palaeókastron*, türk. *Eski-Kalé*, *Ören-* od. *Viránschehr*, arab. *Khırbe*, *Kharaba* u. ähnl.) sind als unerheblich weggelassen worden. Um von denjenigen lebenden Namen, welche durch vollständige oder wenig veränderte Bedeutung der entsprechenden alten Namen ein historisches Interesse gewähren, diejenigen zu unterscheiden, welche aus gelehrter Kenntnis mit dem bei Neugriechen, Italienern, Spaniern in unserer Zeit auflebenden, patriotischen Interesse am Altertum erst wieder neu eingeführt wurden, sind letztere in eckige Klammern [—] eingeschlossen.

Die modernen Namen folgen einer landesüblichen Orthographie natürlich nur, soweit sie Sprachen angehören, welche sich unseres Alphabets bedienen (also den romanischen, der deutschen, polnischen, kroatischen und magyrischen); bei der

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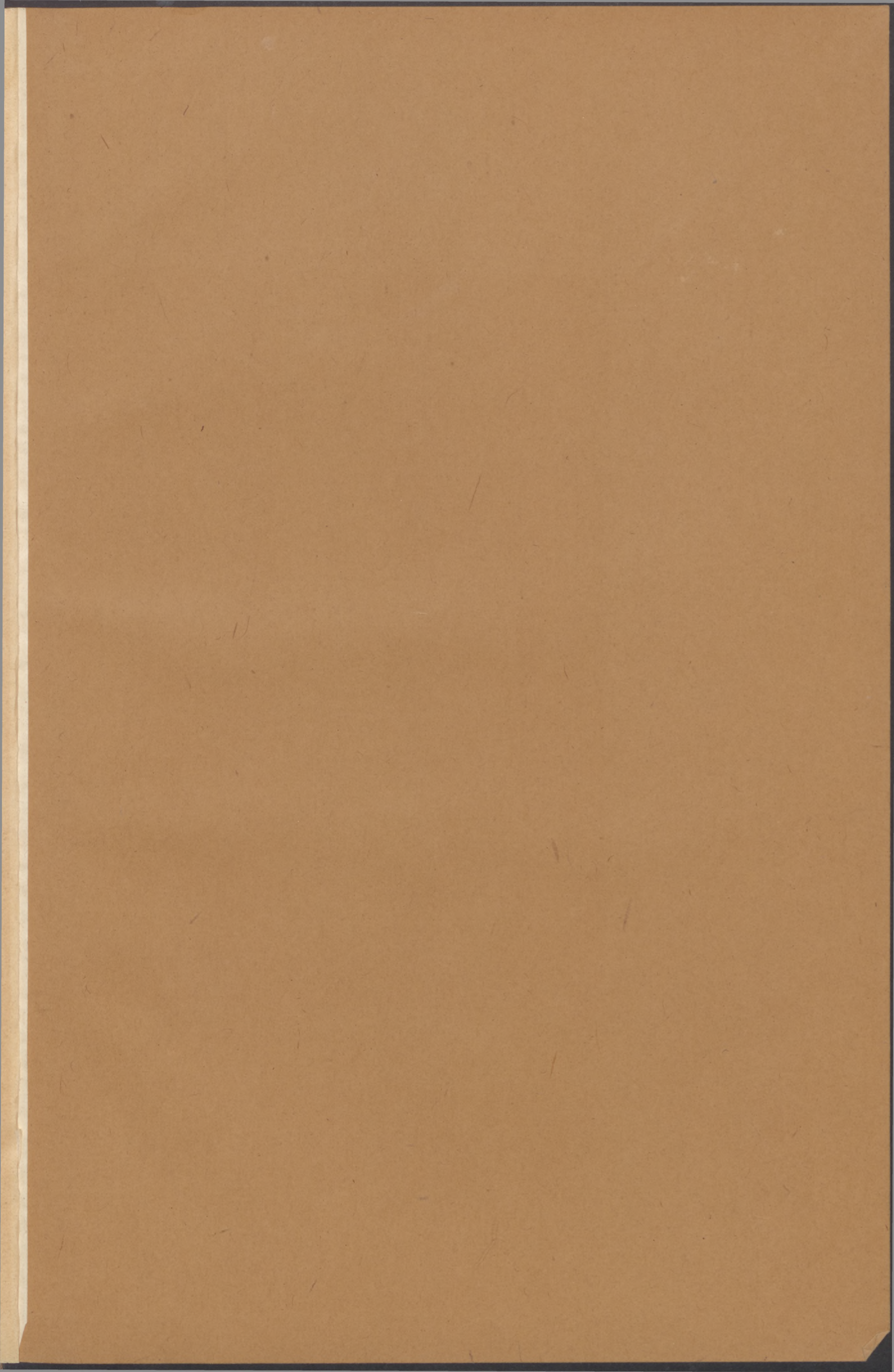
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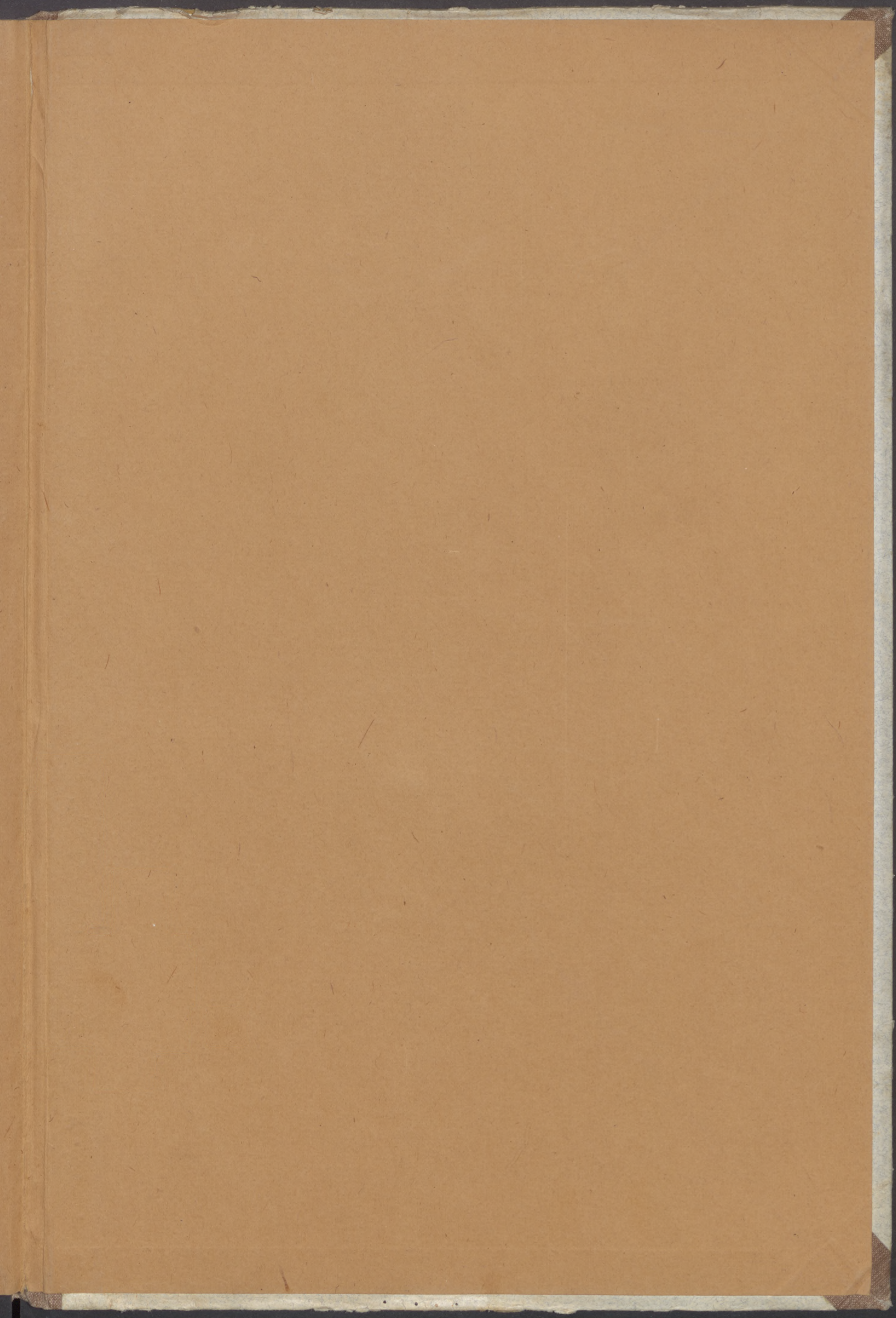
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
