## TELEGRAM

THE Committee appointed to distribute the Public  
Bounty to the Widows and Orphans of those gallant  
Men, (whether Yeomanry, Troops of the Line, or  
Militia,) who fell in the late Rebellion, having, to  
the best of their ability, discharged the trust reposed in  
them, beg leave to lay before the Subscribers the fol-  
lowing statement of their proceedings.

THE Committee appointed to distribute the Public  
Bounty to the Widows and Orphans of those gallant  
Men, (whether Yeomanry, Troops of the Line, or  
Militia,) who fell in the late Rebellion, having, to  
the best of their ability, discharged the trust reposed in  
them, beg leave to lay before the Subscribers the fol-  
lowing statement of their proceedings.

The attention of the Public was first directed to this  
object by an advertisement which appeared in the News-  
papers a few days after the commencement of the Re-  
bellion. A general subscription was urged, as a mea-  
sure demanded alike by Policy, Humanity, and Gra-  
titude; and no sooner was the hint given, than the  
justice of the claim was universally felt, and the plan  
carried into immediate and effectual execution.

On the 12th, 14th, and 16th of June, the first meet-  
ings of the Subscribers were held at the Royal Ex-  
change, and on the last of these days it appeared that  
the contributions in Dublin alone amounted already  
to £.2800. It was then resolved to solicit aid from  
Irish Residents in Great Britain, as being no less inter-  
ested in the suppression of the Rebellion, and in preserv-  
ing the connexion between the two countries. Applica-  
tion was also directed to be made to Mr. Puget to re-  
ceive subscriptions in London, with which request that  
Gentleman immediately complied.

By this Committee (who held meetings twice every week) the plan of distribution was digested, information was solicited, and in order to ensure as authentic a return as possible of the number and circumstances of those entitled to relief, blank certificates were transmitted to the Commanding Officers of all the different Regiments and Corps. These, and other preparatory measures having been adopted, the Committee next proceeded to make a *limited* distribution, which commenced on the 20th of July. Their intention in this step was not only to afford present assistance to those who stood in extreme need of it, but also to enable themselves by actual experiment to proportion the future dividends to the amount of the subscriptions.

With this view the following scale of distribution was agreed upon:

To the Widow of each Private two Guineas for herself, and one Guinea for each child under sixteen years

years of age. If returning to Great Britain, one Guinea for travelling expences was added.

To the Widow of each Serjeant, one half share more.

To the Widow of each Quarter-Master-Serjeant, or Serjeant-Major, two shares.

To the Widow of each Quarter-Master of Cavalry, three shares.

To the Widow of each Commissioned Officer, \* ascertained to be in distress, and to have no other resource, four shares.

Children who had lost their Mothers, as being more destitute than others, were deemed entitled to a Mother's share in addition to their own; and aged Parents, who had been supported by their sons, received a share equal to that of a Widow.

In all these instances the utmost pains were taken to ascertain the just pretensions of the Claimants. The certificate of the Commanding Officer being always required when the facts lay within his knowledge, or if otherwise, of some person of indisputable credit and veracity.

The extreme limitedness of this first Dividend may perhaps appear extraordinary, considering the large distribution which the Committee were enabled to make afterward. But it is to be observed, that at the time of fixing the above scale, it was not known whether any fund

fund would offer itself except that arising from subscriptions in Ireland : The Subscribers in London appearing at that period to have a separate plan in view of a more permanent kind than that adopted in Ireland. Afterwards, however, that idea was dropped, and the whole of their contribution amounting to 4330*l.* 12*s.* 4*d.* entrusted to the disposal of the Irish Committee.

About the time when this business commenced in Dublin, a plan of similar intention was set on foot at Cork ; and, after a correspondence between the respective Committees, it was agreed to consolidate both funds, with this proviso, that as the Widows who had been relieved at Cork had received more than was paid by the Committee in Dublin in their first distribution, such deduction should be made in the subsequent Dividend as would put them on an equal footing with the other objects of the Bounty.

Soon after the Invasion at Killalla, several Gentlemen in Dublin undertook to raise a contribution for the Sufferers on that occasion and in the consequent disturbances in Connaught. But their plan of distribution not exactly agreeing with that adopted by the Committee, the funds were kept distinct. It appearing, however, that from the limitedness of those Gentlemen's object, the relief afforded by them to individuals would be much larger than the more extensive scale on which the Committee proceeded could possibly admit of, it was considered as a necessary act of justice to exclude from any share in the general fund, those who had the advantage of a much ampler and appropriate aid ; a few exceptions, however, occurred, from this exclusive arrangement not being early enough resolved upon.

About the end of October, the applications having nearly ceased, the Committee conceived they might proceed to their principal Distribution. The sum expended on the first Dividend (2199*l.* 16*s.* 9*d.*) was about a fifth of the whole fund. It was therefore now resolved to give at the rate of three fifths—one fifth being still kept in reserve for satisfying such just claims as might have been delayed through accident. But at this stage of the business, the Committee found themselves embarrassed with unlooked for difficulties. The sum to be distributed in the present instance was so much more considerable than the first Dividend, that many who had omitted to put in their claims, thinking the relief to be obtained not sufficient to compensate them for their trouble, now came forward, and, except in their lateness of application, proved themselves as fully entitled as any of the former Claimants.

Instances of this kind became so numerous that the Committee began to fear they would be unable to fulfil their engagements. Two expedients therefore were reported to. The time for receiving applications was, after due notice, limited to the 10th of January; and the humanity of the Public was again applied to in behalf of those whose shares were likely to fall short without farther aid. This second appeal was not without effect. The Committee were enabled to pay all who made their claims within the limited time. But they have had to lament, that several subsequent applications were unavoidably rejected, though in every other point of view, the parties applying were clearly entitled to relief.

It will be observed, that in the following list some of the Claimants are stated to have received less than their due proportion. These reductions arose from its being discovered

discovered that such persons had misrepresented their circumstances, either by giving in the names of deceased children as if they were still living, or of those above sixteen as if they were under that age. The same plan was adopted, where it was found that Widows had married again; or wherever the statement was in any instance proved to be fraudulent.

That the Committee have uniformly escaped imposition, would be much more than they could venture to affirm. The multitude of Claimants, and the nature of the evidence which in many cases they were obliged to rest upon, made it impossible for them not to be sometimes deceived. They can only say, that they neglected no practicable means of ascertaining truth, and of applying with cautious discrimination what had been contributed with such exemplary liberality. They are happy to add, on the authority of several persons of equal intelligence and veracity, that the beneficial effects of this relief have been generally and strongly apparent, especially in those counties which were the actual scene of Rebellion.

The Committee cannot conclude this report without warmly and gratefully acknowledging the munificence of the Subscribers in London, and the benevolent zeal with which Mr. Puget in particular undertook and executed the trust of receiving contributions. With respect to both the one and the other, they are convinced that they speak not merely their own feelings, but those of the Irish Public.
