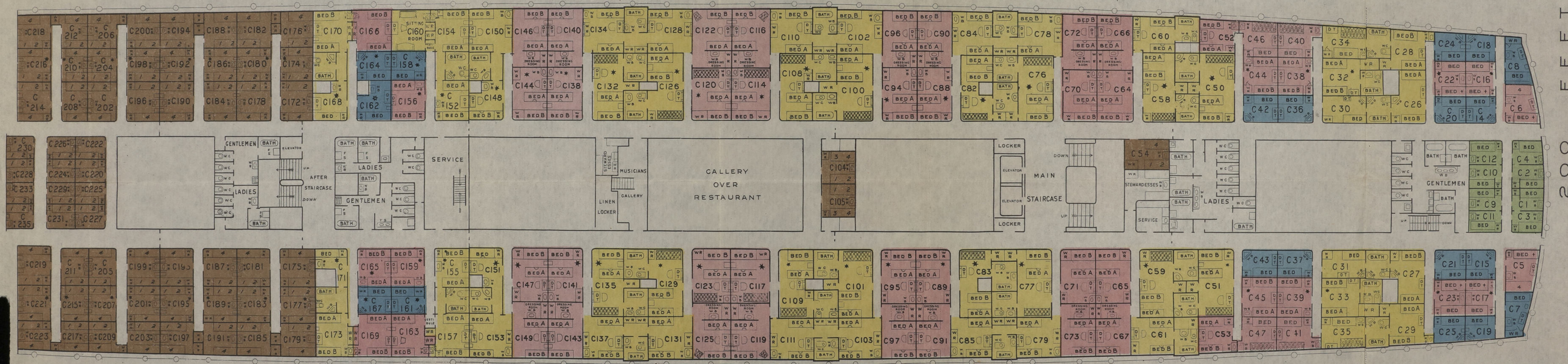

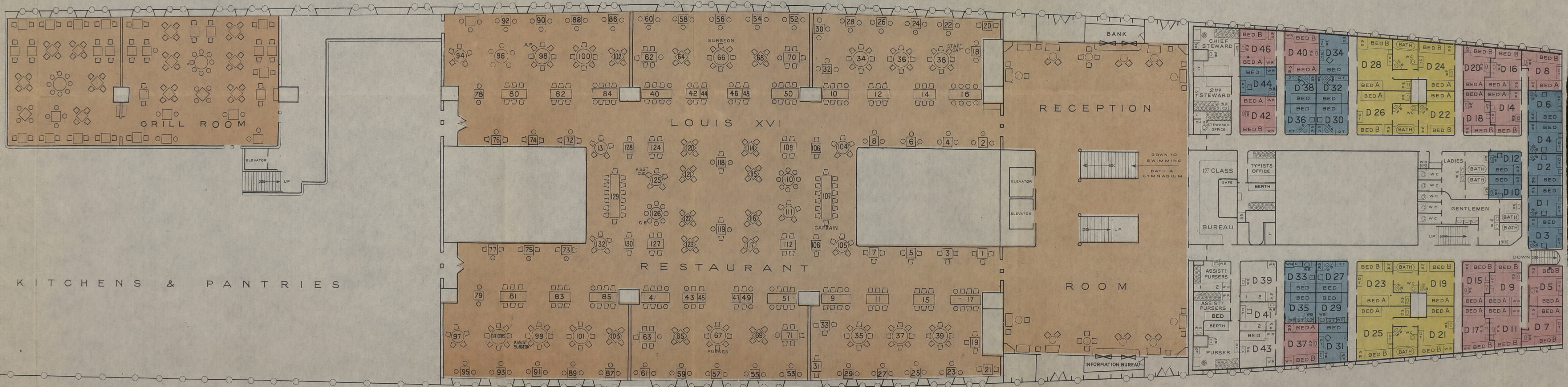

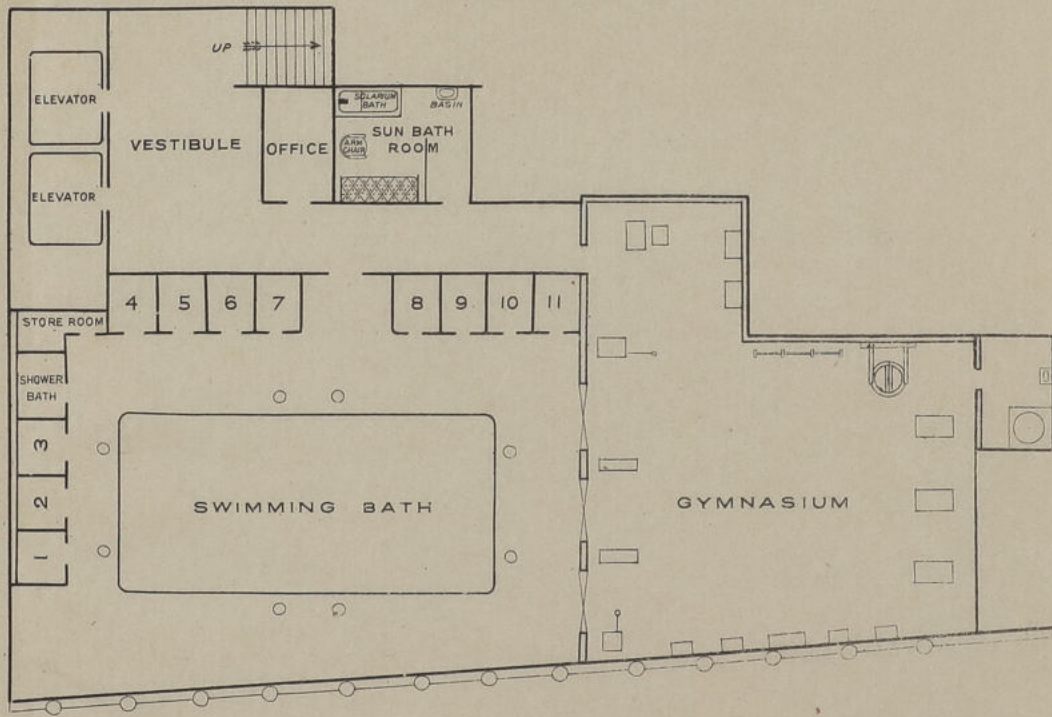

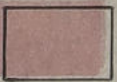
THE PORTHOLES ON D DECK ARE 24 FEET 6 INCHES ABOVE THE WATER LINE.

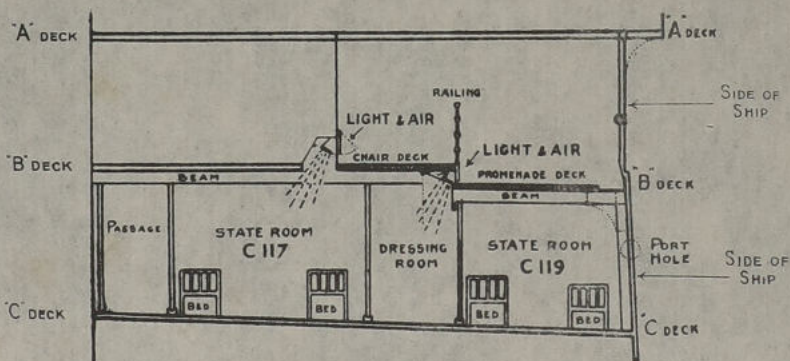
