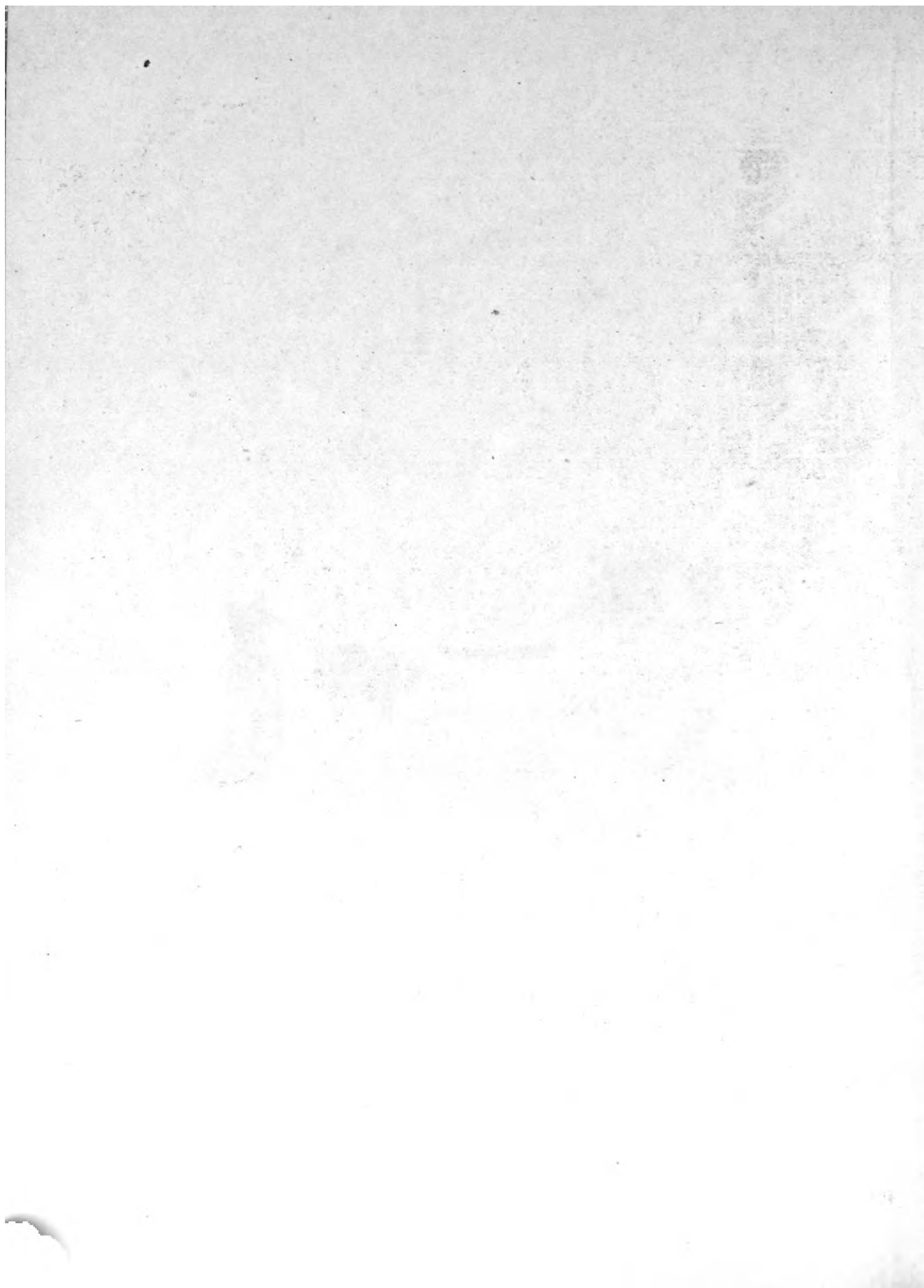

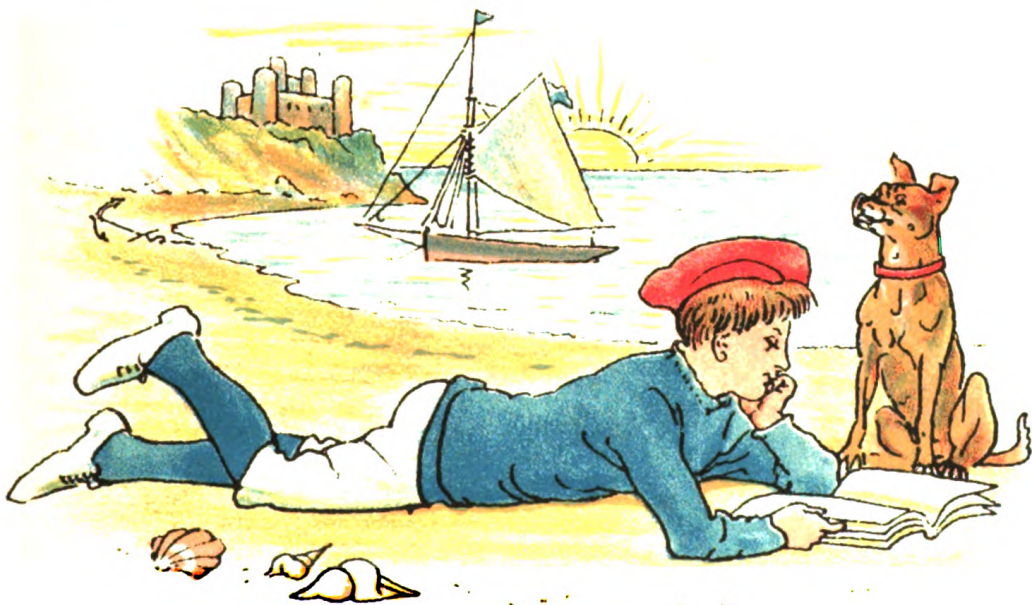

PREFACE

That both Lionels and others may get as much fun out of the book as did its own father and Lionels' - is the wish of both, at any rate

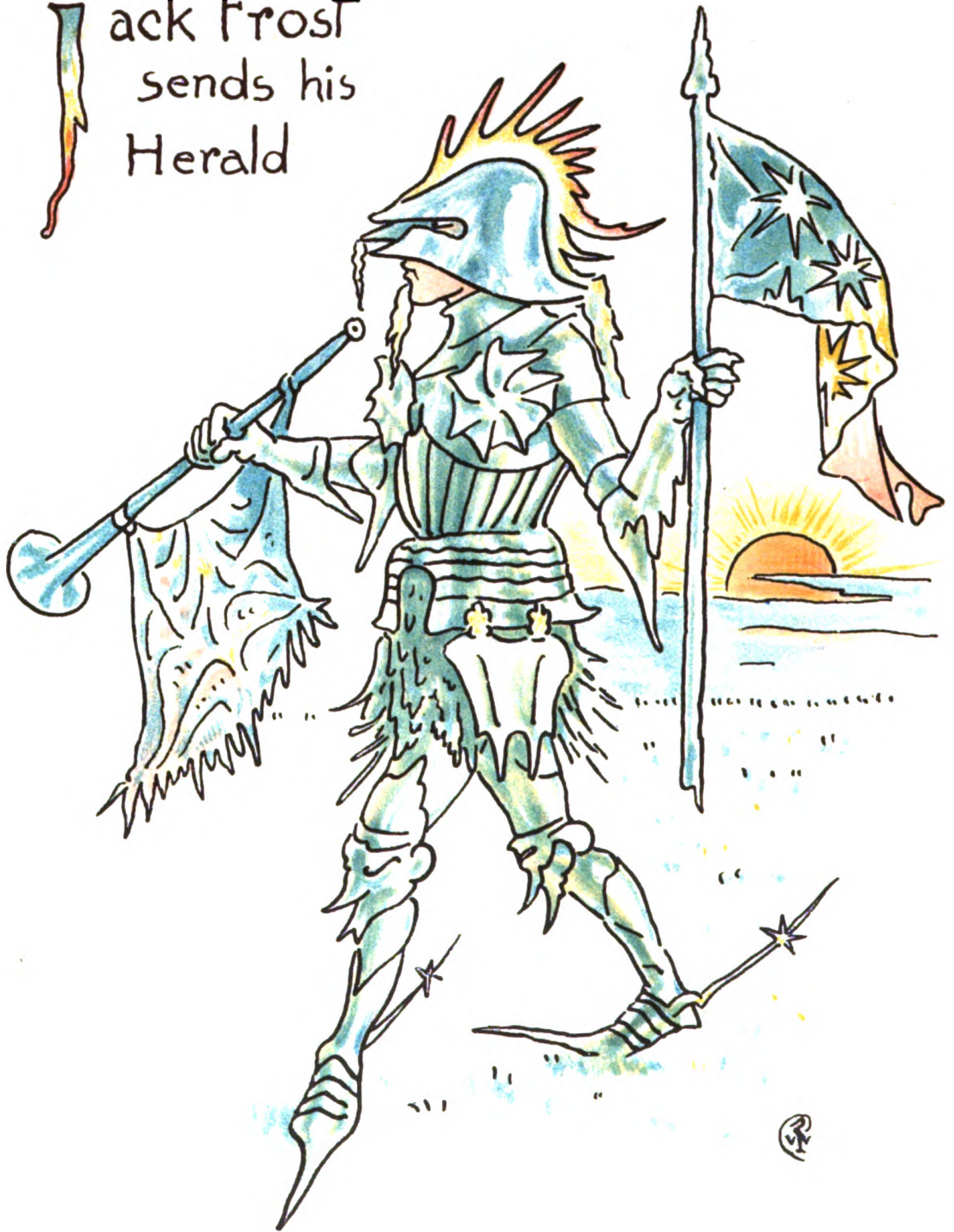
