CONDITIONS OF SALE.

1st, **T**HAT the highest Bidder is the Buyer ; and if any Dispute arise between two or more Bidders, the Book or Books to be put up again and re-fold.

2^d, That all the Books (not otherwise expres'd) are supposed perfect ; but (if any prove imperfect, upon collating at the Place of Sale, the Buyers then to be at Liberty to take or leave them.

3^d, That no Books (*notwithstanding they may prove imperfect*) shall be returned and accepted as such, after once taken away.

4th, That no Person advance less than 3 *d.* under a Crown ; above a Crown 6 *d.* above a Pound 1 *s.* and so on in Proportion.

5th, That each Buyer pay *Five Shillings* in the Pound, in Part of *Payment* for each Lot, if demanded, and also give in his Name and Place of Abode.

6th, That the Books are to be taken away at the Buyer's Expence, within three Days at farthest, after the Sale is ended, and the Purchase-Money paid on or before the Delivery ; in Failure of which, the *Five Shillings in the Pound* deposited in Part of Payment, shall be forfeited, the Books re-fold for the Benefit of the Executors, and the Deficiency (if any) shall be made good by the Buyers.
