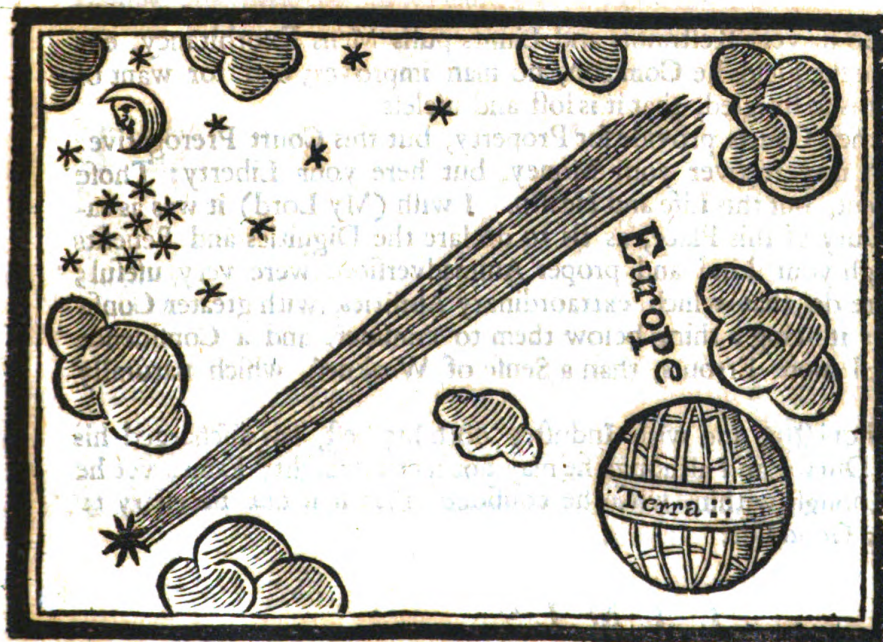

# THE EPISTLE TO THE READER,

Let it be remembered that on the 18th. of May Anno 1680. That the Prodigious storm of Haile fell in and about the City of London, and the Effects of such kind of Haile, we have upon Record in the last year of the Reign of Queen Mary, in and about the Town of Nottingham which was indeed a very great Mortality, & in the same & succeeding year abundance of People dyed, amongst which the Queen was one, and indeed this latter storm hath had pretty smart Effects since the above mentioned Date, and this Prodigious Comet being of such signification and concurring in Nature with that Haile, must of necessity have extream Effects upon the bodies of Man-kind.

Magnitude with a Stream or Blaze pointing Easterly of about 60 Degrees in length, the Star of a Pale Leaner Colour, and also the Stream or Blaze by way of Judgment according to Art, there are two things to be considered, first The place of the Comet in the *Zodiack*, secondly, where the Stream poynts. To the first I do believe it hath past part of *Scorpio* and all *Sagitarium*, therefore let part of *France*, and part of *Germany*, and *Spain* look to it, for they either offensively or defensively shall batter themselves or some other People, and in as much as it is gotten into *Capricorn*, I

pray God keep the Dominions of *Great Britain* in Peace, because under *Cancer* is the North part of *Scotland*, for it is much to be feared that the Scots may once more *Rebell* against *England*, and I must farther take a Cognifance of its passing *Sagittarius*, a figure opposite to *London's* Ascendant, where that great conjunction fell of *Saturn* and *Jupiter* in the year 1663. From which *Mr. Richard Edlin* predicted that great *Plague* which hapned in 1665. In short I fear *England*, but more especially *London* will be incident to an infectious Air, from thence proceeds Raging Pefilent all Difeafes, Rumours and Real Wars and home bred Divifions, poyfoning, open and private Murders, let *England* beware of Flatterers, and treat its Neighbours in a posture of defence. To conclude this part let the Inhabitants of *London* prepare for Death, for indeed a *Plague* is threatened, And God keep back the fury of bloody minded Men.

Then Considering that the poynt at its difappearing tended South-East, let the Inhabitants of other places prepare to feel its Effects as well as we, but not fo soon, by way of Digretion, if I confider the two great Conjunctions of *Saturn* and *Jupiter* which fall in the figne *Leo*, the Ascendant of *Rome* in the Years 1682. and 83. The *World* was never always in one Position, nor hardly ever will. *The Reverend Mr. Perkins* one of the Fathers of the Church in his Reading of the Duration of Kingdoms and States, in many places that they do not for the most part continue above 5 or 600 years at the most, without being Sackt by Strangers, then let the Reader consider whether a great part of *Europe* is not near great Alterations, *England* according to that Doctrine cannot but be very sensible of the sad Effects. 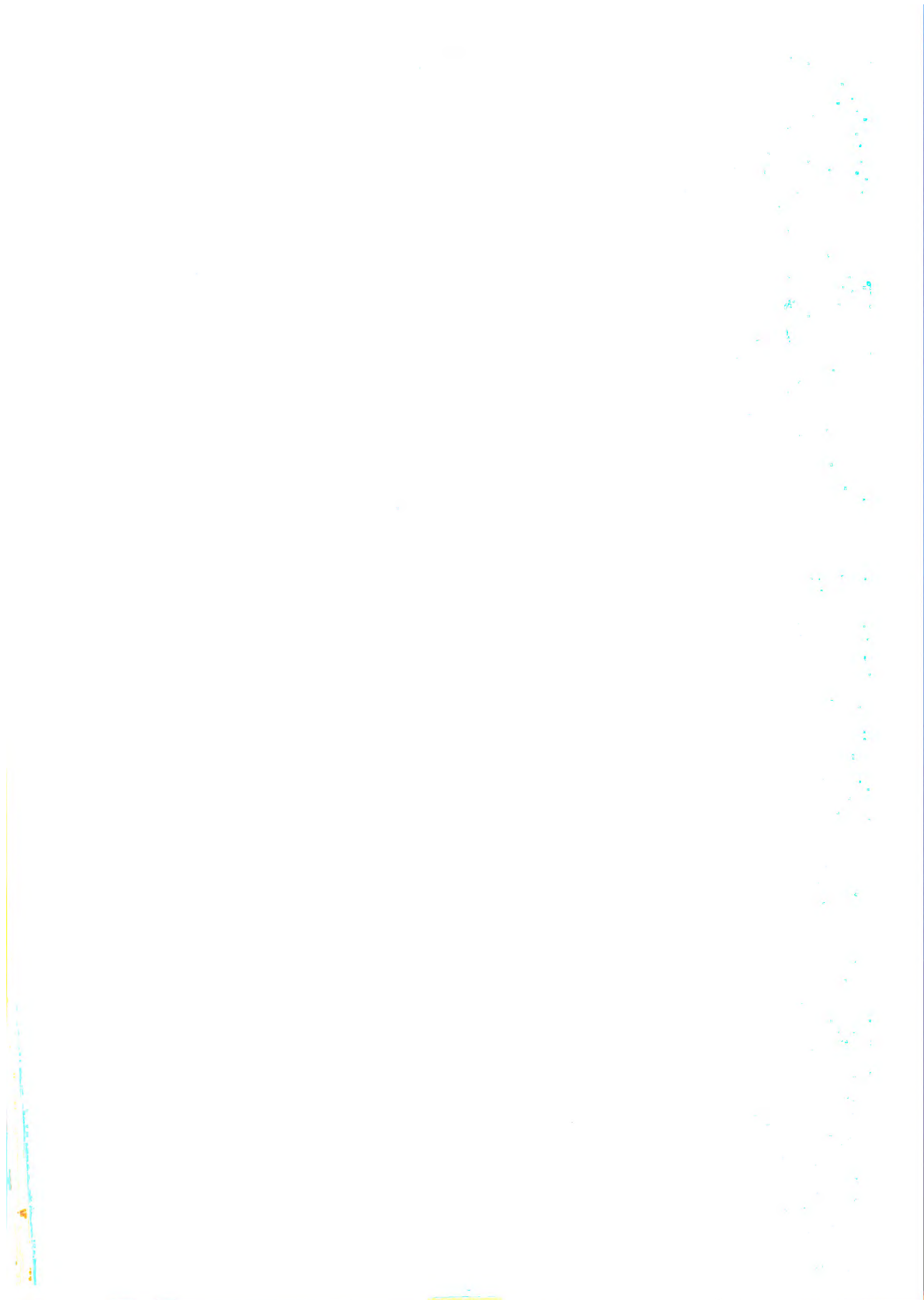

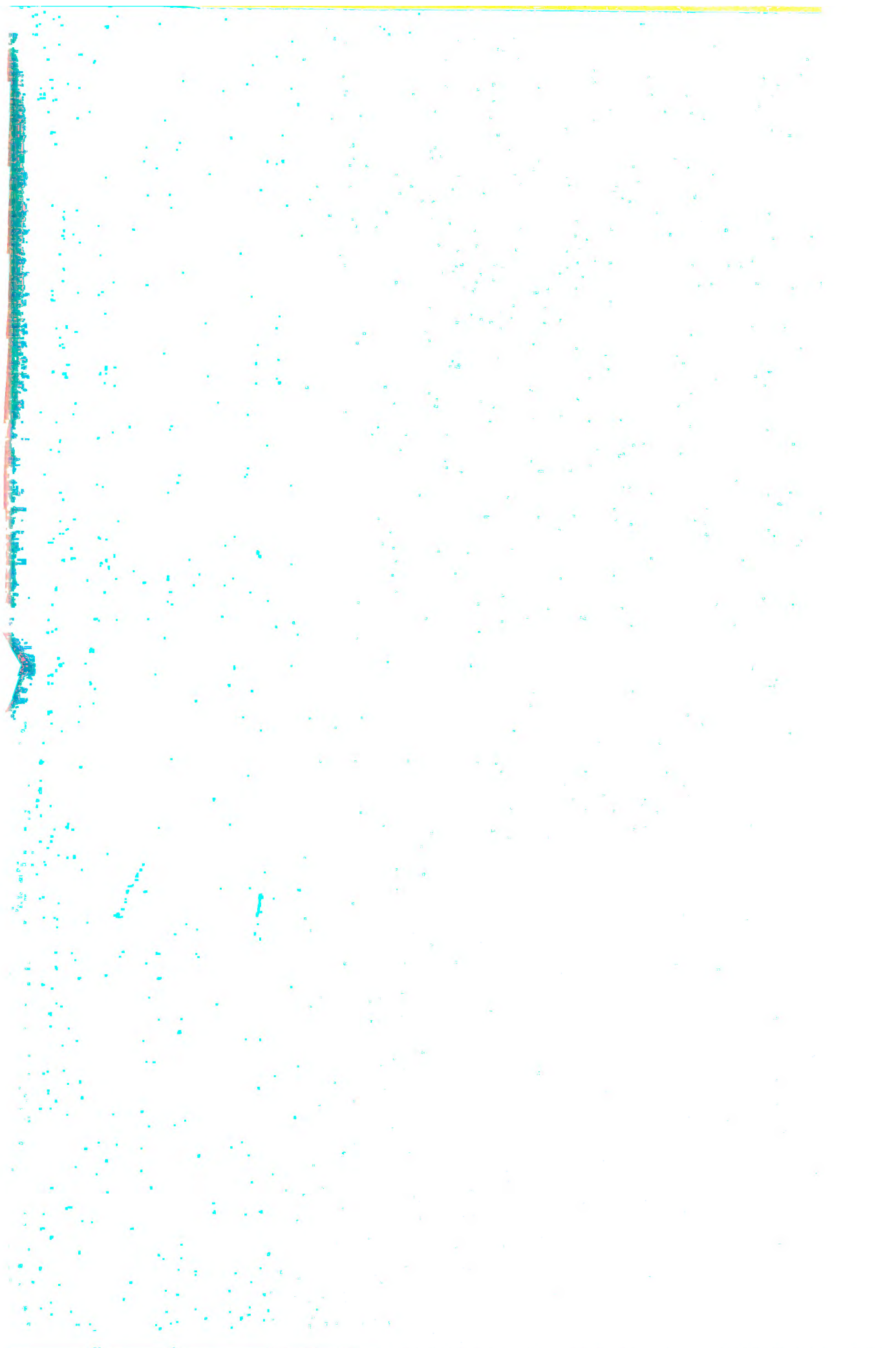

The results of the study are consistent with the research objectives and contribute to the existing body of knowledge in the field. It is hoped that this research will inspire further studies and lead to a deeper understanding of the subject matter.
