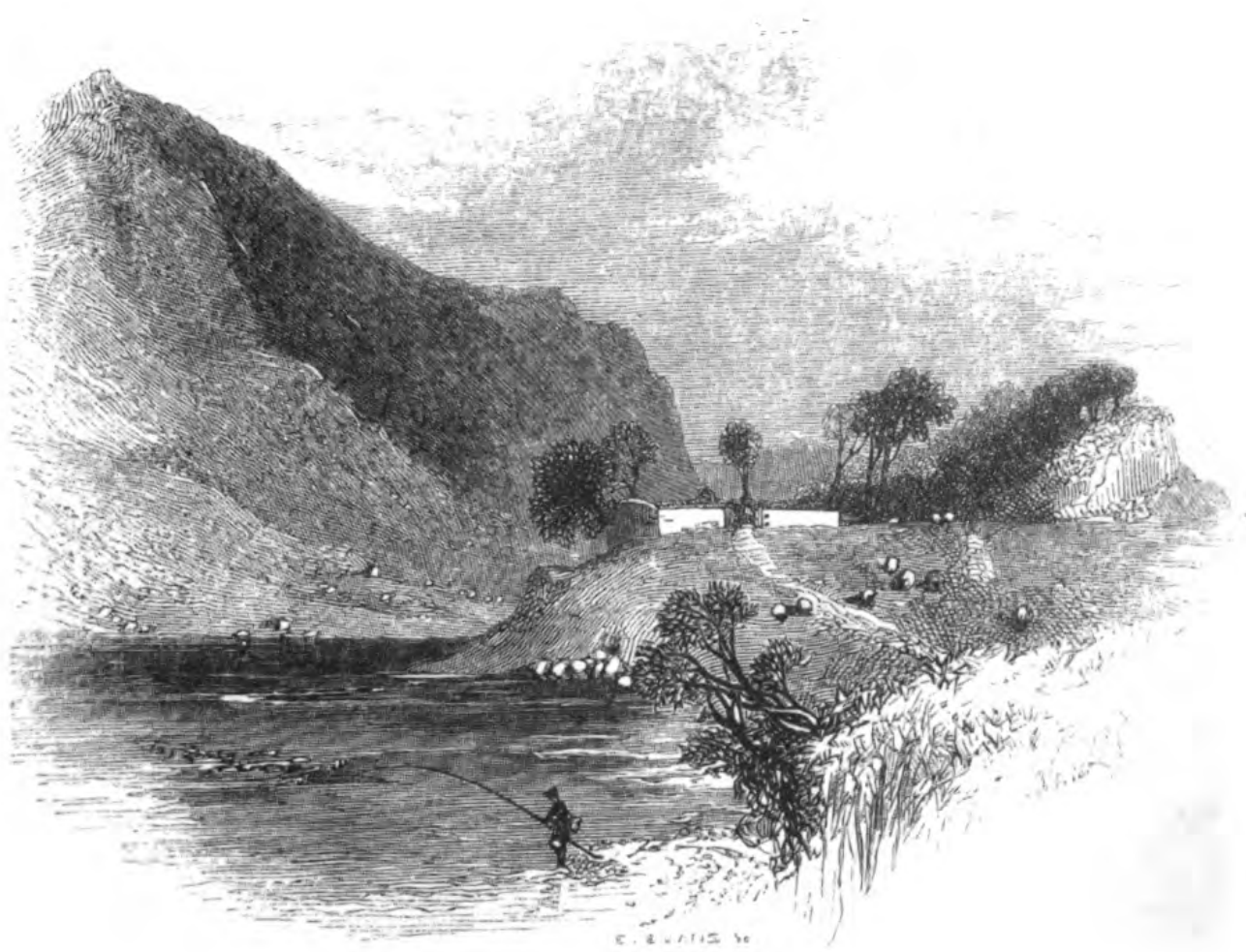

The native bulwarks of the pass.





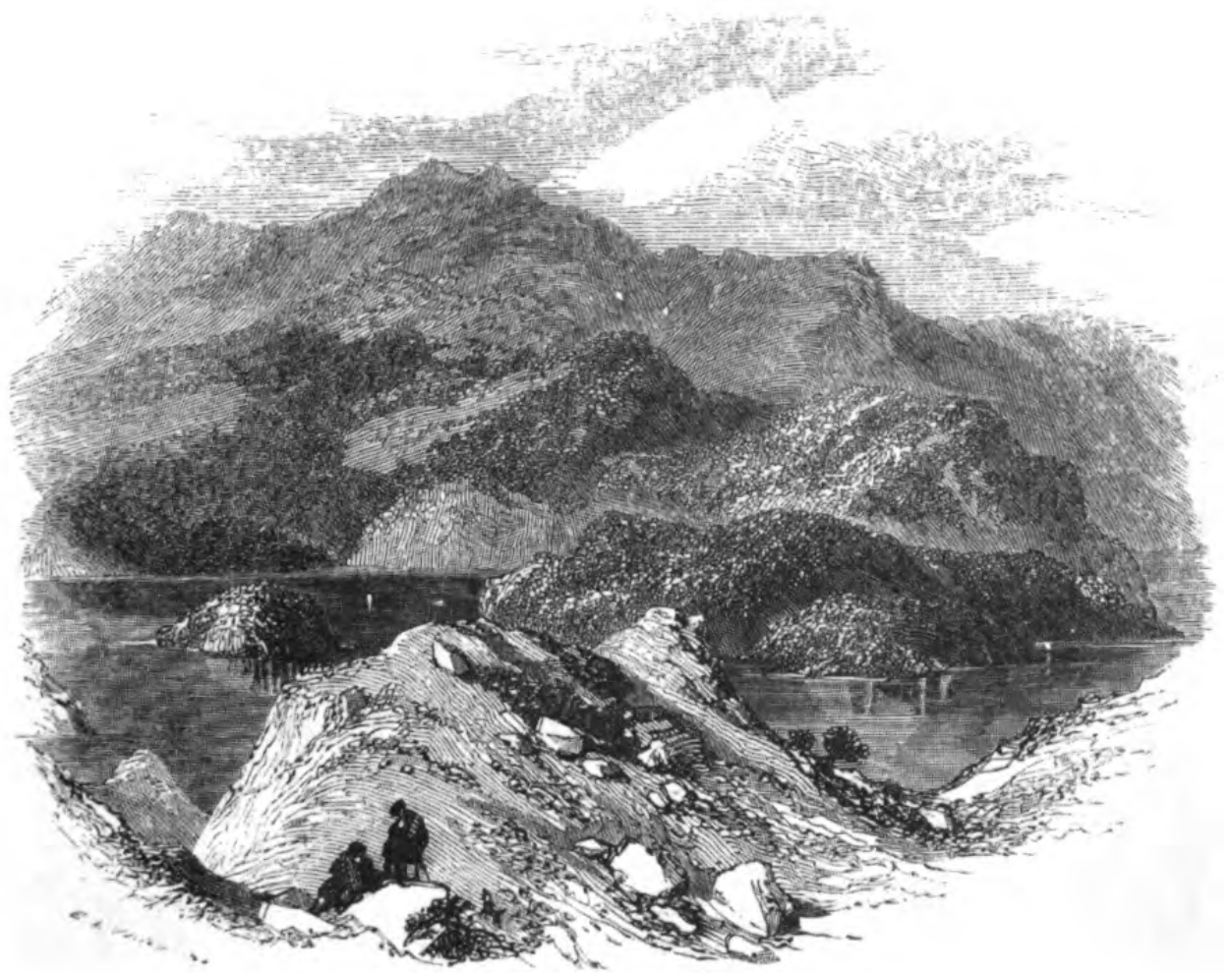

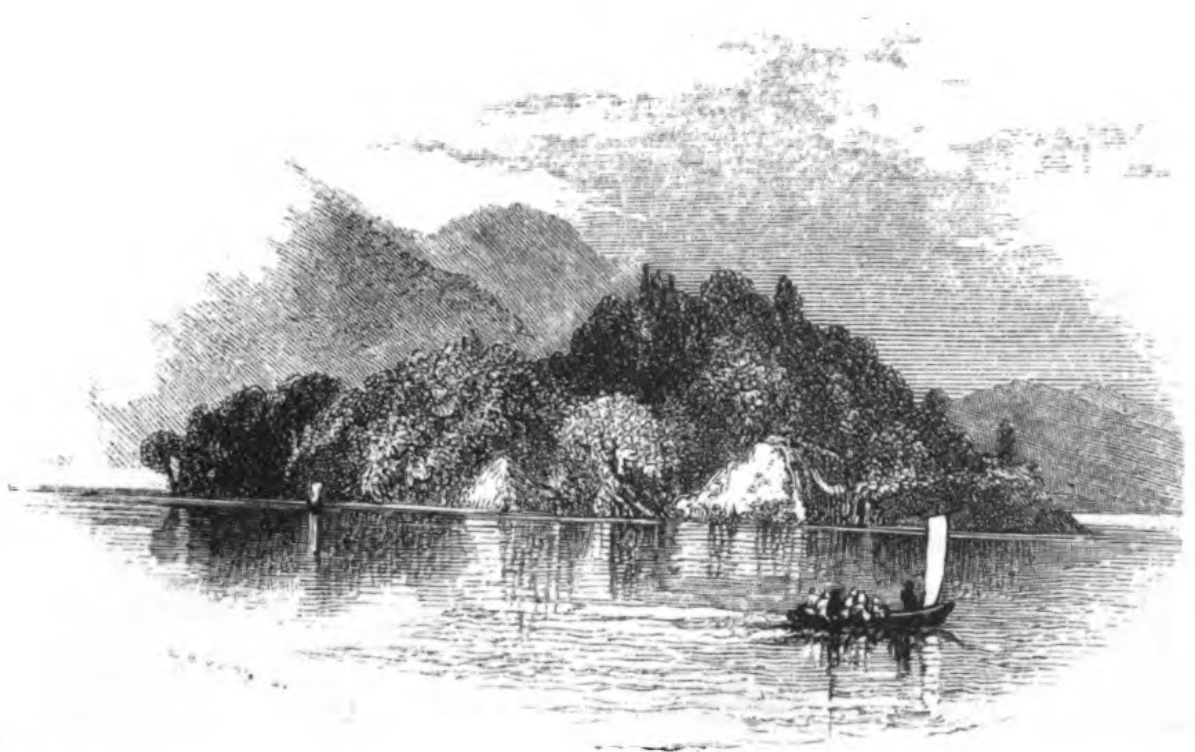

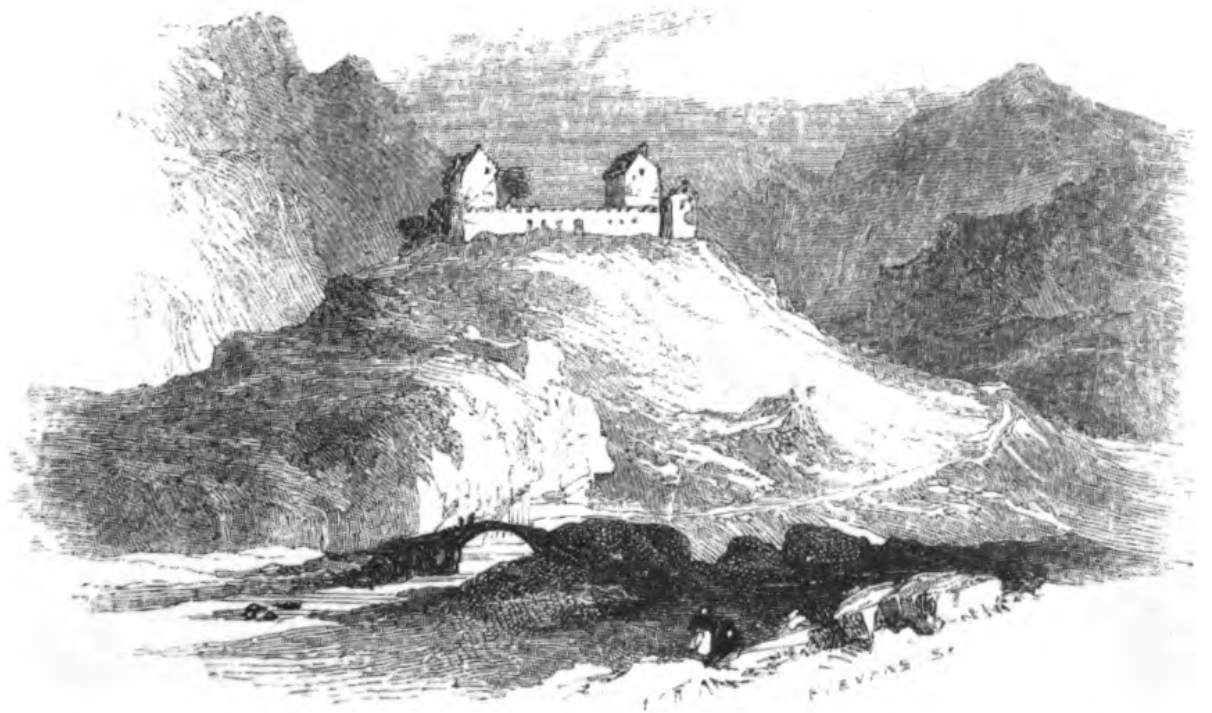

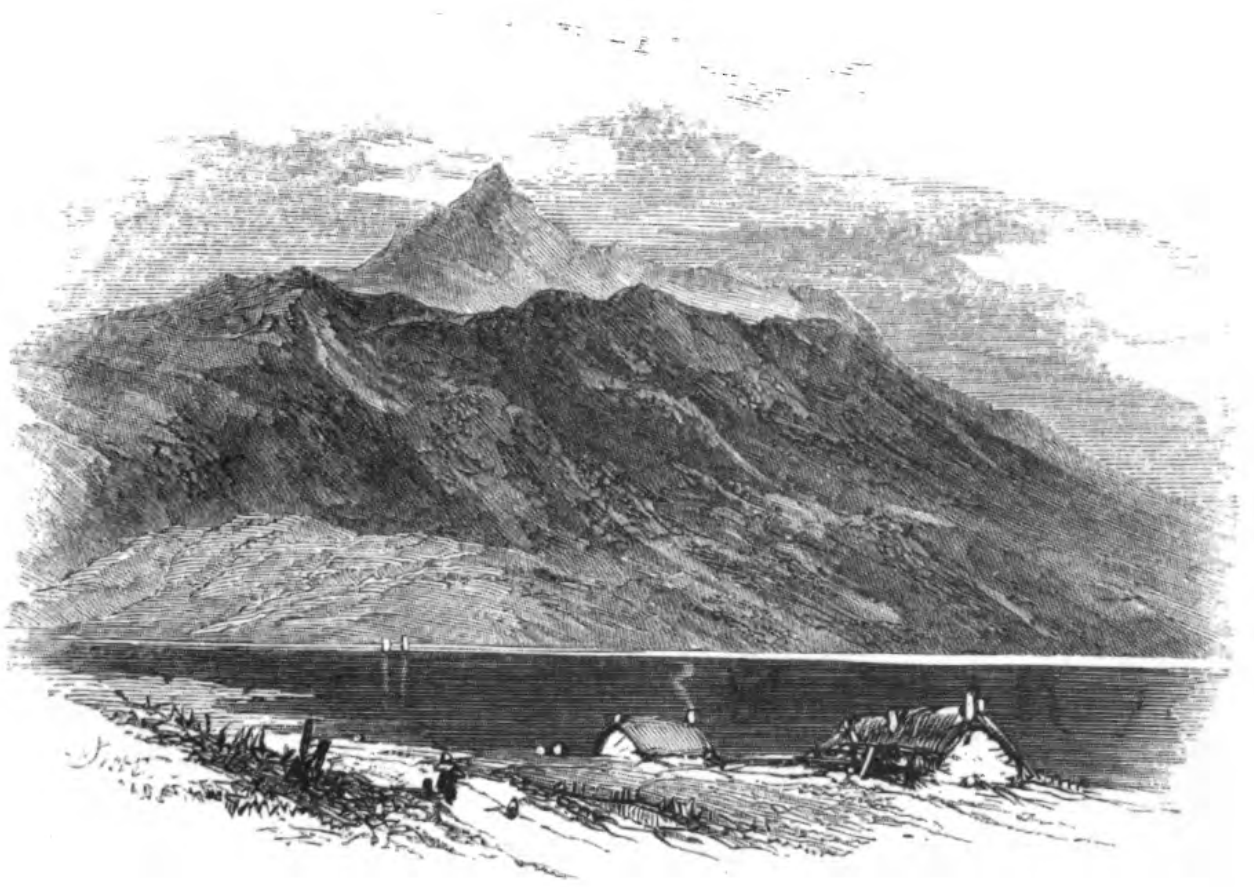

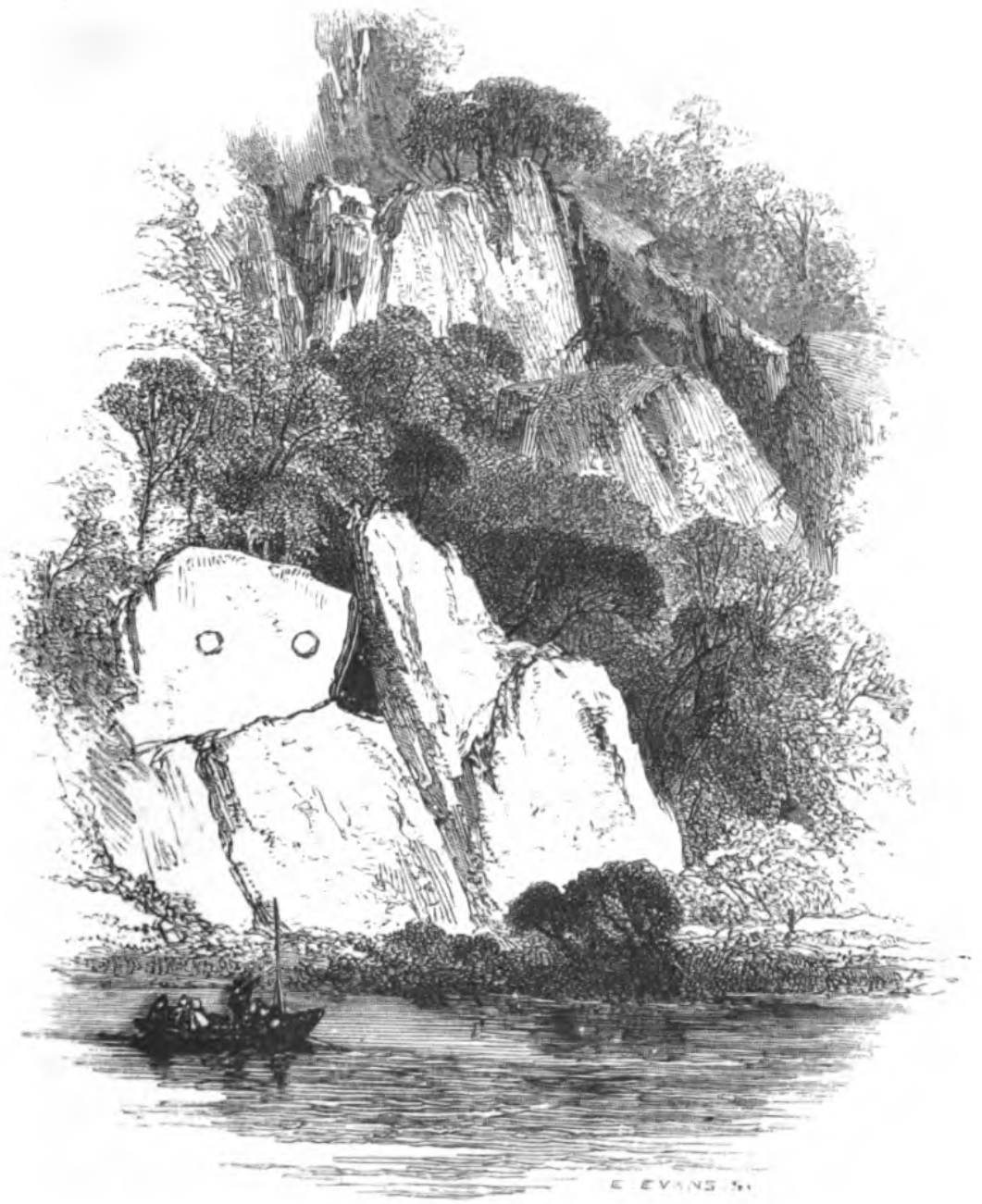
